

ACTION PLAN FOR ONE MILLION TREE PLANTING ON JUNE 5, 2014

Participatory Environment Action Programme (PEAP)-One Million Tree Planting reg.

- 1. Task:** As part of the Participatory Environment Action Programme (PEAP), a special community initiative aimed at wide participatory tree planting, is proposed on World Environment Day 5 June 2014 between 10.30 a.m - 11.30 a.m. This Programme envisages planting One million trees between 10.30 a.m - 11.30 a.m involving various sections of society. The designated hour is to be intimated to all concerned. The programme will be inaugurated in each District at the place decided in consultation with the Hon'ble Minister designated for the District (as per list attached). The programme will evolve as a mass movement for the betterment of the environment. This programme is christened as "HARITHASREE". The programme is built on the philosophy "Oru Manushyanu Oru Maram". This programme will evolve as a plant-and-nurture initiative such that planting leads to establishment and increase in tree cover. Therefore the underlying implication of this endeavor is that "One person plants & nurtures one tree". Accordingly, citizens will be encouraged such that "each person should at least plant one tree on World Environment Day and nurture it till it gets established."

For each district the District Collector (DC) will oversee and the Assistant Conservator of Forests (SF) will be the Coordinator working in close Liaison with District Collector and partner organizations / Institution to conduct and implement the programme in the district. The following activities are proposed in the district:

- (1) Ascertaining the seedling requirement from various departments, organizations, institutions, NGOs/agencies that are willing to take part in the programme.
- (2) Informing the various agencies about the procedure and documentation required.
- (3) Timely supply of required seedlings.
- (4) Conduct of Inaugural Programme
- (5) Overseeing conduct of the programme at the designated hour.
- (6) Obtaining the report of planting from various agencies by 2 p.m on 5th June 2014 and communicating the same to Headquarters by 3 p.m.
- (7) Monitoring of the after care of the seedlings planted.

The APCCF/CCFs/ACFs (SF) will ensure as much participation as possible of all sections of society, particularly farmers & women. In addition the field officials will contact Hon. Mayor/MLAs/Panchayat Residents to request them to plant tree in their respective jurisdiction along with their associates and peers.

Harithasree Cooperatives : For planting and nurturing the seedling and other works related to greening biodiversity, enhancement and improvement of ecosystems a new organization by the name "Harithasree Cooperatives" comprising partner organizations such as Kudumbasree, Bio-diversity Clubs, Resident Association and other organizations/ Institutions & NGO's will be constituted to undertake the planting and subsequent protection of seedlings and other environment improvement activities. The details as regards formation of the Harithasree Cooperatives will be intimated shortly.

2. **Seedling availability:** This year the Social Forestry has produced about 84 lakh seedlings under various schemes. Of this there are one lakh big bagged seedlings about a year old available for planting. The locations of nurseries are given in **Annexure I**. The seedling required for the Harithasree programme will be met from this stock.
3. **Social Forestry Structure:** In each District there is an Assistant Conservator of Forests (Social Forestry). For undertaking the task of a Million tree planting it is proposed to utilize the existing system where the Assistant Conservator of Forests - [ACF (SF)] of each District will be the Coordinator of all activities in the District. The APCCF/CCF of the region will supervise the activities and ensure the smooth conduct in his region. The PCCF (SF) will be the overall charge for the State. At SF Headquarters the DCF (SF) Shri. K. Raju Thomas will coordinate and monitor implementation. The contact details of the PCCF (SF), APCCF/CCF and ACF's is given in **Annexure II**.
4. **Strategy:**
 - i. Kerala boasts of an educated enlightened citizenry hence our first strategy is to rope in various sections of society. The partners of the Haritha Keralam

Programme along with new partners drawn from various segments of society is proposed to make the programme a community movement for the environment

- ii. Unlike other States in Kerala large tracts of government land is not available hence we need to focus on citizens and citizen groups.
- iii. Provide flexibility to officers at field level.
- iv. Provide seedlings free so that participation is wide.
- v. Make seedlings available at easily accessible points.
- vi. Provide an Institutional Framework for Institutionalizing actions.

5. Plan of Action:

- i. **State Level: Partners:** At the State levels partnerships will be arranged and details communicated to the ACF's of respective Districts. For this the PCCF(SF) will also liaise and obtain partnership from media, religious groups, political groups, LSG, Education department, Higher education Department, Kudumbashree, NSS, NCC, SPC, Police, Postal Department, Indian Navy, Army, Railway, NGO's etc. The DCF(SF) HQ will follow up and obtain the saplings required by each organization and ensure maximum and wide participation. The seedlings required by each of these organizations and the place at which required will be obtained by the DCF (SF) HQ and communicated to the ACF's of the respective district.
- ii. **District Level:** The District Collector will oversee implementation at the District. The ACF (SF) will be the Coordinating Officer. The DC will call for partners and obtain wide participation and intimate the seedlings required by each organization for planting at the designated hour. The first District meeting is expected to be held on 27 May 2014 to identify partners and quantify the requirement of seedlings. At the District level the DC/ACF's will seek partners from amongst LSG's, resident associations, sacred grove owners, media, religious groups, political groups, education department, higher education department, NSS, NCC, SPC, Police, Postal Department, Indian Navy, Army, Railways, government offices, corporate bodies, active NGO's, Kudumbasree etc. The organization doing the planting must be informed that more than planting, the upkeep and survival of the planting is

also mandated. One individual is to be assigned to each seedling. This is of vital importance. The arrangements made must be spelt out by the participating organizations- how they will tend to the seedlings for the first year. The ACF's are expected to arrange for the distribution at least 1 lakh seedlings in the district such that planting takes place within the designated one hour. The DC/ACF will intimate to participating organizations the designated hour during which the seedlings are to be planted, the procedures to be followed, and the documentation required.

The ACF's are required to obtain feedback from the schools and other organizations as regards the number of seedlings required. The ACF's will arrange to reach the seedlings to the school/organizations by 2nd June 2014 or latest by 10 a.m on 03..06..2014, so as to enable the institutional authorities to start distribution of seedlings by 10 a.m on 03..06..2014. The Head of Institution/Organization shall maintain a register indicating the individuals participating in the programme, the seedlings planted, the time of planting and other details in the format given in **Format I**. The individual student planting the seedling in own homestead will submit and report to Principal in **Format II**. The Head of Institution / Organization will certify the number of seedlings that have been planted during the designated hour in the format as given in **Format - II**.

The participating organization will submit the **Format III** report to the Coordinating Officer - the ACF(SF) of the district by 1 p.m on 5th June 2014. Photo documentation by self where possible may be uploaded on face book site. The facebook page name (URL) [www. facebook.com/harithasreekerala](http://www.facebook.com/harithasreekerala) other options will be intimated shortly. The FMIS wing of KF&WLD will prepare and manage the Face book site. Initially it is being done by M/s Invis. The ACF (SF) of each district will arrange for several teams to video document the exercise such that maximum areas are covered.

- iii. **School level :** The General Education Department, Director VHSE, Director Higher Education and DPI have been requested to send instructions to all the concerned subordinate officers in this regard. The requirement of seedlings will be reported to the ACF(SF) by the DD concerned by 26th May 2014. The ACF's will collect the details from the District Level Officers with name of schools, number of seedlings required, place of delivery etc. by 26th May, 2014. The seedlings are to be delivered to the schools latest by 10 a.m on 3rd June 2014. Seedlings as required by Kudumbasree and other organizations may also be delivered at the school for which the Head of Institution/ Principal shall be suitably informed. The Head of Institution/ Principal shall take care of the seedlings till the time of distribution. The Principal/ Head of Institution shall maintain in a Register in **Format - I** indicating the details of seedlings assigned to each student for planting and nurturing. Seedlings assigned to the school/college will be planted in the school/colleges premises. If there is no space in the school/ college premises, the Principal may allow willing students to plant in their homestead at the designated hour. Principals may limit the number to a reasonable figure that is easy to monitor. A certificate to the effect that such seedlings are planted by them during the designated hour will be furnished by the student and as verified by the parent, to the Principal/ Head of Institution in Format II. The Principal / Head of Institution in turn will furnish a certificate as regards the number of seedlings planted in the designated hour by the Institution in Format III . Documentation as indicated in the Action Plan is to be followed.
- iv. **Other Green Partners :** For all other groups such as visual media, religious, political parties, Indian Navy, Postal department etc the above procedure is to be followed. For each of these groups arrangements for transport of seedling are to be made in advance, preferably by 3rd June, 2014 such that planting is possible at the appointed hour on 5 June 2014. Documentation as indicated in this Action Plan is to be followed..

6. Responsibilities:

A. Departments:

(a) Forest Department :

- (1) Ascertaining and assessing seedlings required by each organization and making the same available well in time.
- (2) Instructing the participating organization is to the procedures and documentation.
- (3) Conduct of Inaugural programme.
- (4) Overseeing the Planting Programme.
- (5) Obtaining report from the organizations (through District Collector wherever applicable) by 1.00 p.m of 5th June 2014 and consolidating and intimating to HQ by 2.00 p.m of 5th June 2014.
- (6) The APCCF/CCF(SF) shall intimate the PCCF(SF) details by 3 p.m of 5th June 2014
- (7) Documentation in each district and monitoring.
- (8) Co-ordinating and ensuring proper participation.

(b) Participating Organization

- (1) Intimating required number of seedlings after ascertaining space available for planting
- (2) Assigning one individual to each seedling.
- (3) Receipt, planting and nurturing of seedlings.
- (4) Monitoring and Registering details above.
- (5) Documentation of seedlings planted
- (6) Reporting of seedlings planted by 1.00 p.m on 5th June 2014 to ACF(SF).
- (7) Regular monitoring of seedling growth.

(c) District Collector

- (1) To oversee at district level.

B. Individuals

- i. Over all charge:- PCCF (SF).
- ii. State level monitoring and daily reporting:- DCF (SF), HQ.
- iii. Regional monitoring:- APCCF/CCF.
- iv. Over all charge of district, conduct of Inauguration:- District Collector/ ACF.
- v. District seedling requirement ascertaining/assessing/supply/obtaining certificate, assist District Collector in Inauguration, obtaining documentation, monitoring and reporting formats from participating Organisations/ Institutions - ACF(SF) of District.
- vi. Planting at designated hour and its after care, submitting certificate of planting:- Head of Institution/organization.

7. Launch of the Programme : In each district the District launch will be conducted by the District Collector with the Minister in charge of the concerned District. The programme will be launched by the Minister designated for the District. The Panchayats may organize programmes at their headquarters in a befitting manner. Like-wise each participating institution will be encouraged to organize a ceremonial function in a befitting manner. The State Launch will be undertaken in Kottayam. At Kannur the Hon'ble Chief Minister will launch the programme. On this day the Forest Department would honour the supporters of conservation and the various green partners. "Vanamithra Award-2013" will also be distributed during the State level launch at Kottayam.

8. Documentation

The most important aspect of this mass planting is the proper documentation of one million trees planted in the designated hour. For this we are largely depend on the authenticity of reporting. The Principal/ Head of Institution/Organization may closely supervise this. The following records may be monitored closely.

a) Register:

Each organization/ institution shall maintain a register in format given in **Format I**, which shall detail the name of person to whom the seedlings is assigned for planting and nurturing and related details.

b) Certificate

(i) Each Individual undertaking planting will give a certificate to the head of Institution / Organization given in **Format II**, indicating the time and place of planting.

(ii) The Head of Institution/Organisation will give a Certificate as given in **Format III** indicating the number of seedlings planted in the designated hour. The certificate shall reach ACF(SF) by 1 p.m on 5th June 2014. Information can send by fax/email. In unavoidable circumstances intimation can be given by phone which should be post confirmed by email/fax at the earliest.

c) Uploading in the face book

Face book account is created for this mega event. Individuals/Institution may upload details in the following site **www.facebook.com/harithasreekerala**

d) Photo documentation:

Besides the above, APCCF/CCF/ACF (SF) must ensure that the Organizations/ Institutions as well as Social Forestry Officials themselves arrange for photo documentation as well as video documentation of the functions at as many places as possible.

d) Using Mass Media

Assistant Conservator of Forests (SF) may inform various mass media channels both audio and visual to actively participate in this programme and prepare extensive photo and video documentation.

e) **Reporting back to headquarters.**

Having obtained the correct picture of total number of seedlings planted by various Organizations/Institutions, the field officers (APCCF/CCF/ACF (SF) must compile the district wise details and send to PCCF (SF) office latest by 3.00 p.m on 5th June.

9. Monitoring

The ACF(SF) shall have in place a system of monitoring planting activities in the designated hour on 5th June 2014 as well as follow up monitoring. The Chairman of the Committee formed for the purpose of seedling distribution will conduct a documentation and monitoring on 5th June 2014. Competitive programmed to increase documentation may be explored

10. Follow up

Each Head of Institution/ Organization is required to conduct follow up action, for this regular monitoring as required is to be carried out.
