## ORDER

RULE 24, Kerala Services Rules Part 1 lays down that unless the Government to view of the Special circumstances of the case, shall otherwise determine, after five years continuous absence from duty, elsewhere than on Foreign Service, whether without leave, an officer ceases to be in Government employ. The question has now been considered whether in the case of deputation to Foreign Service also the maximum period of deputation should be fixed. The Government consider that the maximum period should be limited to five years. They accordingly direct that, unless otherwise decided by them in view of the special circumstances of the case, the maximum period of deputation of officers in the Government Service to Foreign Service be five years.
