ORDER

At present there are no statutory rules or executive order for the verification of the character and antecedents of candidates recruited to the Contingent Establishment. The Inspector General of Police in his letter read above in has raised the question whether verifications is necessary in the case of candidates selected for contingent posts.

Government, after careful consideration of the question, order that no detailed verification of character and antecedents is necessary in the case of candidates selected for appointment to contingent posts will be asked produce two certificates of character in the appended form issued by any two of the following authorities.

1. Gazetted Officers of the State Government, Central Government & Kerala State Electricity Board
2. Stipendiary Magistrates,
3. Members of Parliament,
4. M.L.As,
5. Mayors of Corporations
6. Chairmen of Municipalities
7. Heads of Private High Schools, and
8. Presidents of Panchayats

The appointing authorities will ensure that the certificates are coined before the candidates are actually appointed.
