**ORDER**

According to G.O.F1-3965/49/DD. Dated 3-12-1949 issued by the Travancore-  
Cochin government 25% of the vacancies in the ranks of Asst conservator of Forests  
were reserved for promoted officers, that is, for every three direct recruits appointed as  
Asst. Conservator of forests, one Ranger had to be promoted. The Madras Forest Service  
rules provide that direct recruitment and recruitment by transfer of asst, conservator of  
forest shall be made in the proportion of 3:2. The question of fixing a proportion between  
direct recruitment and recruitment by transfer in the cadre of Asst Conservator of forest  
in Kerala State has been engaging the attention of Government. Government are pleased  
to order that, pending issue of the Kerala forest service special rules, direct recruitment  
and recruitment by transfer of Asst. Conservator of Forests will be made in the  
Proportion of 3:2. These orders will take effect from 1-11-1950
