ORDER

In the G.O. read above orders were issued that relatives of Jawans killed in action or reported missing will be given priority in recruitment through Employment Exchanges. The Director of employment in his letter 2nd cited has reported that the above concession could not be availed of by majority of persons as most of them are over aged. Hence the Director has recommended that the age concession given to the physically handicapped persons may be allowed to the relatives and dependents of Jawans also in order to enable them to avail of the above concessions.

Government have examined the above proposal and are pleased to order that in addition the priority sanctioned in G.O. read as 1 st paper above an age concession of 10 years over and above the existing upper are limits will be allowed to the relatives and dependents of Jawans killed in action or reported missing for purpose of recruitment to various services through Employment Exchange.
