ORDER

In the G.O. read as second paper it is stated that Government in the administrative Department concerned shall pass orders appointing the dependents of Government servants who die in harness who are recommended for appointment in Government service after following the procedure laid down therein. It is not the intention that Government will have to function as the ' appointing authority" in such cases, Government will only issue an order sanctioning the appointment of the candidate and it is for the appointing authority to issue the formal order of appointment.

2, It has also come to the notice of Government that in some cases such appointments are being made without prior verification of character and antecedents of the candidates as is being done in the case of others who are appointed by direct recruitment through the normal channel. Government there fore wish to clarify that verification of character and antecedents is necessary before the dependents of Government servants who dies in harness are appointed to Government Service. The appointing authority will arrange for the verification of character and antecedents in accordance with the procedure laid down in G.O first cited after getting the attestation form filled in by the candidate.
