ORDER

According to para 2 of the G.O. cited, Government Servants who retired from service on or after 15-7-1966 will be allowed to return to service. Doubts have however been raised whether Government servants whose date of birth is 15-7-1911 and who retired from service on superannuation at the age of 55 can return to service under the above orders. Government are pleased to clarify that Government servants whose date of birth is 15-7-1911 and who therefore retired with effect from 15-7-1966 F.N. are entitled to return to service, subject however to the conditions laid down in the G.O. cited.
