ORDER

Government have examined the question of regularization of the period of absence in the case of officers who have been compulsorily retired under rule 60 A Part 1, K.S.R. and subsequently reinstated in service and who have superannuated before the orders revoking their compulsory retirement have issued. They are now pleased to issue the following orders further to orders issued in the G.O. read above.

- (i) In respect of all those who have superannuated before the issue of orders of revocation of their compulsory retirement on compassionate grounds the period during which they were out of service shall be treated as duty, and they will be given full pay to which they would have been entitled, had they not been compulsorily retired, together with any allowances for which they were entitled to prior to their compulsory retirement.
- (ii) In the case of officers whose orders of compulsory retirement have been revoked on sympathetic grounds and reinstated in service the period of their absence from duty shall be regularized by granting leave without allowances. Pay and allowances will be paid to them only from the date on which they assumed charge of the duties of the posts.
