Dated, Trivandrum, 23rd November, 1983.

Sub:- Pension-Counting of aided School Service put in by Government servants prior or entry in Government Service for purposes of pension-Recording of certificate-Modification-Orders issued.

Ref:- Circular No. 29/71/Fin. dated 16-4-1971.

In the circular cited, it was clarified that both teaching and non-teaching service in aided schools put in by Government Servants will count for pension and that this benefit will be admissible to Government servants other than teachers also.

2. It was further clarified therein that information regarding Government's/Manager's share of Provident Fund contribution and details of service in aided schools have to be furnished by officers of the Education Department and in the case of officers of the Education Department, the certificate in the Service Book may be recorded by the District Educational Officer or the Director of Public Instruction as the case may be. In the case of Officers of other departments necessary information may be obtained from the concerned officers of the Education Department and the required certificate recorded in the Service Book by the concerned pension sanctioning authorities. It has come to the notice of Government that this procedure causes difficulties to officers whose pension sanctioning authority is other than the head of the department.

3. To mitigate the hardship caused in such cases, Government in partial modification of Para (viii) of the circular cited, are pleased to order that in the case of officers of departments other, than Education Department necessary information may be obtained from the concerned officers of the Education Department and the required certificate recorded in the service Book of the head of the department/pension sanctioning authority.
