ORDER

The Salvages felling scheme work was initiated in 1969 to extract depot supply Timber in about 20,000 Hectors of occupied forest areas in Aiyapenooil and kumily Ranges. The original proposal was to extract the timber from 23 coupes. Chattikuzhi Coupe Nos.1 11 and A Thopramkudy Coupe Nos. 1 and 11 are among the 23 Coupe thus.....The work in these coupes has already been started. New the Chief Conservator of Projects has sought formal sanction for taking up the above works departmentally and requested to sanction the following estimates.

Chattikuzhi Coupes No.1 :	Rs.43,28,820/-
Chattikuzhi Coups No.11 :	Rs. 17,05,00/-
Thopramkudy Coups No.1	:Rs. 40,37,700/-
Thopramkkudy Coups No.1	:Rs. 21,97,330/

Total Rs. 1,22,09,850/-

The estimates include have provision for taking up the works at an over all increases of 21% of the departmental basic rats. Provision for lopping as well as employing skilled laborers to guide trees to the right direction of the felling using coir, vadams etc. and using of hired elephant at the rats of Rs. 5.28 instead of admissible rate of Rs. 1.75

2. In Governments have examined the proposal in detail. In the circumstances reported by the Chief Conservator of Forests Government are pleased to accord sanction to take up the above works departmentally. Government also approve the estimates proposes by the Chief Conservator pf Forests subject to the condition that the ... for hired elephants will be the old rate (Rs. 1.75) and not Rs. 5.28, shown in the estimates.
