**ORDER**

In his letters read above, the Chief Conservator has reported that Shri. K. Kunju Kunju, Street No.2/216, Cheralarikadavu, Kochi has bid for 19.114 Cubic meters of Rose Wood from Pathanapuram Timber Depot on 24.2.1978 and he failed to remit the balance value within the stipulated time. The timber was re-auctioned at his risk and loss as per sale conditions. In the re-auction Government sustained a loss of Rs. 1, 45,963/79 (Rupees One lakh, Forty five thousand, Nine hundred and Sixty three and pause Seventy nine only). Hence action for the recovery of the amount was taken against Shri. Kunjukunju under the Revenue Recovery Act. But the amount of loss could not be realized from the defaulter under the Revenue Recovery Act as there was no movable or immovable property in his name. In the circumstances the Chief Conservator of Forests has requested that the amount of Rs. 1,45,963.79 being the loss sustained by Government in the Re-auction of the Rose Wood mat be written off and the defaulted bidder Shri. Kunju Kunju may be black listed.

2. Government have examined the matter in detail and are pleased to order that the amount of Rs 1, 45,863.79 (Rupees One lakh, Fortyfive thousand, Nine hundred and Sixty three and Paise Seventy nine only) towards the loss sustained by Government in the Timber auction held pathapuram Timber Depot in February, lives be written off. Government also order that Shri Kunju Kunju Street No.2/216, Cheralayikadavu, is blacklisted permanently and he will not be permitted to enter inter any contract with the Government of Kerala in future.
