S R O No. 548/77. In exercise of the powers conferred by subsection (1) of section 2 of the Kerala Public Services Act, 1968 (19 of 1968), read with section 3 thereof the Government of Kerala hereby make the following amendment to the Kerala Civil Services(Classification, Control and Appeal) Rules, 1960, namely:-

AMENDMENT

In the said rules, 23 the existing Note shall be membered as note I' and after Note I, as so much numbered , the following Note shall be added namely:-

Note2. Tabsildars working as Land Tribunals and the staff working under them shall be entitled to appeal to the Land Board against an order passed by the District Collector under these rules:.

Explanatory Note

(This note is not part of the notification, but is intended to indicate its general purport)

In G.O. (Ms.) No. 569/75/ Revenue dated 21.6.1975, Government have empowered the District Collectors to impose the penalties of censure, fine, withholding of increments and recovery form pay on Tabsildars working as Land Tribunals and on the staff working under them. It has been decided that the appellate powers on the orders passed by the District Collectors may be delegated to the Land Board. This notification is intended to give statutory validity to the above decision of Government.
