S.R.O. No. 520/75 – In Exercise of the powers conferred by sub section (1) of section 2 of the Kerala Public Service Act, 1968 (19 of 1968) read with section 3 thereof, the Government of Kerala hereby make the following amendments to the Special Rules for the Kerala Secretariat Subordinate Service issued under G.O. (P) No. 208 of the Public (Rules) Department dated the 5th July 1967, and published in part I of the Kerala Gazette No. 27 dated 11th July 1967, as subsequently amended, namely:--

AMENDMENTS

In the said Rules—

1. In subrule (a) of rule 4 --

(a) for the entry against, category 8 (b) “Assistants Grade II, in Departments other than the Governor’s Secretariat”. In column 2, “Method of appointment” the following shall be substituted, namely:-

“Direct recruitment.

Note :-- Typists with four year’s aggregate service in the Secretariat or Office of the Public Service Commission and Typists and Clerks in all Departments with four years’ aggregates service irrespective of graduation qualification will be allowed to compete in the written test conducted by the Public Service Commission for selection as Assistant, Grade II in the Secretariat. The age limit for selection in the case of such persons will be 32 years on the first day of July of the year in which applications for appointment are invited by the Public Service Commission with the usual relaxation for scheduled castes/Scheduled tribes and other backward classes. They shall take their chances for appointment purely on the basis of merit and considered against open competition vacancies and not against turns reserved for particular communities”.

(b) for the entry against category 12 “Lower Division Typist” in column , “Method of appointment” the following shall be substituted, namely:-

“Direct recruitment.

Note:- All Persons holding low paid posts (included in any of the Subordinate Services under the State Government), whether they possess the minimum general educational qualification of the S.S.L.C standard or not, and who possess the basic qualification in typewriting prescribed as minimum qualification for appointment as Typist shall be allowed to appear for the annual competitive test conducted by the Public Service Commission appointment as Lower Division Typist subject to the following conditions, namely:-
