**ORDER**

According to the orders relating to inter-departmental transfer of government Servants contained in the first four G.O's read above, a person transferred from one subordinate service to another or from one unit to another within the same service is allowed to count his former service for purpose of probation in the latter service provided all his seniors in the latter service/unit have had sufficient time to complete probation within the described period. It has been found that the above stipulation is contrary to the orders regarding probation issued in the G.O. read as fifth paper since incorporated in the special rules for various services. According to the rules, a transferee has to undergo fresh period of probation in the post to which he joined on transfer. In the circumstances it is considered necessary to issue executive orders on the line of the provision in the special rules.

Government therefore in consultation with the Kerala Public Service Commission order in partial modification of the G.Os. read above that an inter- departmental transferee will have to undergo probation in the new department in accordance with the special rules. In the case of inter- departmental transfer to the service for which special rules have not been issued, the transferee will not be allowed to count his service in the former service or unit for purpose of probation under any circumstance and in such cases the probation will be regulated in accordance with the orders contained in G.O. (MS) No. 188/PD dated 6.5.1966.
