Sub:- Delegation of powers to the Officers of the Forest Department

Read: 1. Again Government Circular L.Dis. 9417/56/Cs dated 4.3.1956

2. Correspondence resting with letter No. G-1-2013/56 dated 8th April 1956 from the Chief Conservator of Forests.

ORDER R.Dis 3293/56/Rd

Government consider that for the speedy and expeditious dispatch of work in the Forest Department, more powers have to be invested in the Chief Conservator of Forests and his subordinate officers.

2. Government are therefore pleased to sanction the following powers being delegated to the Chief Conservator of Forests and the Divisional Forest Officers in respect of forest contracts (supply contracts and mellabhom contracts):

I. The Chief Conservator of Forests will grant extensions of period of contracts up to maximum period of one year, subject to the imposition of penalty as provided in the agreement relating to such contracts.

II. The Divisional Forest Officers will grant extension of the period of chalans for remittance of 2/3 auction amount, up to maximum of 6 months from the date of expiry of the grace period and a similar extension of period of passes for removal of timber, on payment of usual penalties or ground rent as the case may be.

3. Sanction is also accorded for the additional financial powers as detailed in the enclosed statement, being delegated to the Chief Conservator of Forests and other officers in the Forest Department.
