S.R.O. No. 68/77- In exercise of the powers conferred by sub-section (1) of section 2 of the Kerala Public Services Act, 1968 (19 of 1968), read with section 3 thereof, the Government of Kerala hereby make the following amendment to the Kerala Service Rules, namely:-

AMENDMENT
(C.S.. No. 310/77)

In Para I of the said rule, in rule 60-A after sub rule (2) and the Explanations there under, the following sub rule shall be inserted namely:-

“ (3) The Government may on application of any officer compulsorily retired under sub rule (1) review order under that sub rule and pass such order as they think fit:

Provided that no such application shall be entertained unless it is made within thirty days from the date on which the order was received by the applicant”.

There is no provision at present to review cases where officers are retired under rule 60-A Part I, Kerala Service Rules. The above provision is introduced with a view to give an opportunity to such officers for filing appeals, if desired, for consideration of Government.
