**Explanatory Note**

(This does not form part of the Notification, but is intended to indicate its general purport.)

As per G.O.MS No. 14/78/GAD. Dated 10/1/1978 sanction was accorded for the creation of a post of Field Director which is equivalent in Status and responsibilities to these of the Conservator of Forests. The Field Director has to sign bills, award contracts etc. as is being done by the Conservator of Forests. Therefore, it is considered necessary to appoint the Field Director, Periyar Wild Life Sanctuary as a Forest Officer, vested with powers to carry out the duties and functions of a Forest Officer under the provisions of the Kerala Forest Act and the Rules made there under. This Notification is intended to achieve the above object.
