ORDER

In the G.O read as first paper orders were issued for a maximum of 20 appointments in all every year in the State services, Subordinate Services and Last Grade Services in posts mentioned in the list appended to the G.O being set apart for appointment of the outstanding Sportsmen/ women to the Public Service without consulting the Kerala Public Service commission. It was also ordered that the procedure and modalities for recruitment under the scheme would be prescribed separately. By the G.O read as second paper the Kerala Public Service Commission (Consultation) Regulations, 1957 were amended to exclude the appointments from the purview of the Public Service commission.

2. Government are pleased to approve the scheme appended to this order for the appointment of outstanding Sportsmen/ women in Public Services.

APPENDIX

Scheme for the appointment of outstanding Sports Persons in Public Service.

- (1)** This scheme shall be called “ Scheme for the appointment of outstanding sports Persons in Public Service”
- (2)** Only outstanding Sports Persons who have represented the country at the Olympics or the Asian Games or the Commonwealth Games Meets and those who have achievement in National Meets, Inter University Meets (interzonal) and State Championships as laid down in Annexure I and and who posses the minimum educational qualifications prescribed for the posts notified, shall be eligible for appointment under the scheme. The Government may, at their discretion, relax the general educational qualifications prescribed for any post in the case of persons with exceptionally outstanding achievements in sports and games like representing the country in Olympics, Asian Games or Commonwealth Games.
- (3)** Twenty appointments will be made every year in posts enumerated in Annexure II subject to availability of suitably qualified persons.
- (4)** The selection of outstanding sports persons for appointment made by a Committee consisting of Commissioner & Secretary, General Administration Department as Chairman, Secretary, General Education Department, Director General of Police, Director of employment and the President, Kerala Sports Council as members.
- (5)** The sports persons who wish to pursue the sports career shall be appointed against supernumery posts created to accommodate them in departments. They shall be absorbed against regular posts in the departments on retirement from active sports.
- (6)** The sports persons who have retired from active sports, selected for appointment, shall be straightaway appointed against regular posts in the departments.
- (7)** The active sports persons appointed against supernumerary posts shall be given regular coaching and this will be arranged by the Heads of Departments in consultation with the Kerala Sports Council.
- (8)** The Government shall determine whether active persons or those have retired from active sports career or both should be selected during a years, the number to be selected in each category and the departments and posts in which they should be appointed having regard to their qualifications, including achievements in sports.
- (9)** The details of posts in which appointments will be made in a year the qualifications fixed for the posts, the relaxation in educational qualification available for persons with exceptionally outstanding achievements in sports, the departments in which the appointments will be made, if determined, shall be announced in the notification inviting applications.
- (10)** The sports persons who have outstanding achievements in sports mentioned in Annexure I who posses the minimum general educational qualifications prescribed for the posts or relaxed educational qualifications for exceptionally high achievements in sports and games will be called for test and / or interview. The selected candidates for each category of post shall be ranked in the order of merit for allotment and appointments.
- (11)** The Selection Committee may avail of the services of experts or other persons to assist them in the conduct of test and / or interview.
- (12)** Selected candidates will be allowed to the departments for appointments against regular or supernumerary posts as the case may be. The required number of supernumerary posts shall also create simultaneously.
- (13)** The Rules in the Kerala state and Subordinate Services Rules, 1958 and the special rules in regard to age , probation etc., shall apply to the sports persons appointed under the scheme but the rules regarding reservation of appointments shall not apply.

- (14) Rules regarding verification of character and antecedents shall apply in the case of candidates appointed under the scheme. The candidates allotted for appointment under the scheme shall be initially appointed temporarily under General Rule 9 (a)(i) of part II of the Kerala State & Subordinated Services Rules, 1958 and regularized later after their character and antecedents have been verified and found to be satisfactory.
- (15) The year for their purpose of the scheme shall be reckoned as the Calendar year.
- (16) The General Administration (Ser.F) Department shall be the Secretariat Department for the administration of the scheme.

ANNEXURE

Sports Persons Eligible for Appointment under the Scheme.

- (i) Those who have represented the Country in International Competition viz. Olympics, Asian Games / Common Wealth Games.
- (ii) Those who have represented the State in National Meets and won places.
- (iii) Those who have represented the University in all India University Games (Inter-Zonal) and won first places.
- (iv) Those who have won first place in State Championship
