ORDER

In the case of Typists in non- Secretariate department, there exists a ratio of 1:1:2 among senior grade, upper division and lower division. It has been represented to government that typists who get the promotion to higher grades based on the ratio of 1:2:2 might be allowed to continue in the offices where they are working at the time of their promotion irrespective of the fact whether they belong to upper division or senior grade.

2. Government are pleased to order that whenever a typist in the Secretariate department is promoted to the U.D. or Senior Grade he/ she can be allowed to continue in the same office where he/ she is working at the time of promotion as the promotion does not involve any change of duty.
