

Circular No.15/1964

During my camp in Panniyar area, it was noticed that the Guards and Foresters engaged in the watershed plantation there were provided with temporary sheds inside the plantations itself. Due to their presence throughout the planting period inside the plantations, they could supervise the planting work to the fullest extent and consequently the plantations have been a remarkable success. If we have to get all our plantations to such a degree of perfection, I think, we have to ask our field staff to live in the plantations itself, at least during the planting period. Therefore, it is hereby ordered that the planting staff, like Foresters and Guards should be provided with temporary sheds inside the plantations itself and amount for such sheds included in the planting estimate. They should be asked to live in the plantations during the planting period.
