FAMILY PENSION TO THE SPOUSE OF THE SECOND MARRIAGE OF THE GOVERNMENT SERVANT WHERE THE SPOUSE OF THE FIRST MARRIAGE IS NO MORE—
ORDERS ISSUED

ORDER

As per G.O. (P) No. 181/91/Fin. dated 7-3-1991 orders were issued to the effect that spouses will be eligible for family pension even if their marriage took place after retirement from service of the Government Servant.

But now a question has come up as to whether family pension can be sanctioned to the spouse of the second marriage. At present there is no rule to sanction family pension in such cases.

A large number of requests has been coming to Government in this regard.

Government have examined the matter in detail and are pleased to order that, spouse of the second marriage will be eligible for family pension, even if their marriage took place after retirement from service of the Government Servant provided the wife/husband in the first marriage is not alive and also subject to the following conditions.

- (a) To produce necessary certificate duly certified by the Notary Public of the locality to the effect that the spouse of the first marriage is not alive.

(b) To produce another certificate/documents duly certified by the Notary Public of the locality to the effect that the marriage of the deceased Government Servant with the applicant was lawful and legally valid one.

Necessary amendments to the Provisions in Kerala Service Rules will be issued separately.
