NOTIFICATION

In exercise of the powers conferred by the proviso to Art 309 of the Constitution of India the Governor of Kerala hereby makes the following amendment to the Kerala Service Rules published under notification No. Fin.(CR). 57702/59 dated 10-11-1959, namely:-

AMENDMENT

After Note (2) to Rule 93, Part I of the said Rules, the following shall be added as Explanation :-

“Explanation – The three years limit shall include,

- a. all periods of leave during which the Government servant would have officiated in the post but for proceeding on leave; and
- b. all periods of officiating service rendered in an equivalent or a still higher post but for the appointment to which he would have officiated in that post.”
