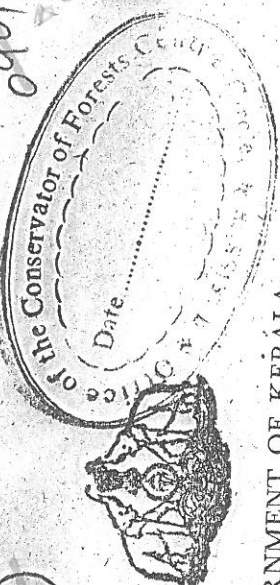

Read:— Letter No. FMI/9-230/93-94/10 dated, 19-4-1993 from the Accountant General (A&E), Kerala, Thiruvananthapuram.

ORDER

The Accountant General in his letter read above has pointed out that a review was made by them to find out why many Fund deductions made from Accounts. In many cases such transactions have been misclassified under General Provident Fund (Kerala) and this causes much difficulties in timely authorisation of final payment to AIS officers. This is because the schedule and bill form used by All India Service Officers are the same as that of General Provident Fund (Kerala). To overcome this problem, the Accountant General has suggested to introduce distinctly coloured Provident Fund schedule and Bill forms for All India Service Officers.

Government have examined the matter in detail and are pleased to order that blue coloured forms shall be used for Provident Fund schedule and Bill forms for All India Service Officers.
