Sub:- General Provident Fund (Kerala) Rules withdrawal from the Fund-Fixing up of upper monetary limit for various categories of sanctioning officers in the Forest Department-Officers included under different categories of sanctioning authorities-specified-orders issued.

Financial powers sanctioned to various officers of Forest and Wild Life Department were revised vide Government orders read as first paper and second paper above.

In the Government Order read as third paper, upper monetary limit for sanctioning Temporary Advance/Non-Refundable Advance from General Provident Fund by different categories of officers in various departments was specified by Government. Government have also ordered that the categorisation of officers and monetary limit fixed now shall be in supersession of all existing orders issued in the matter and Heads of Departments shall issue an order specifying the designation of officers under their control to be included under the categories mentioned in the Government Order read as (2) above.

In the above circumstances the upper monetary limit for sanctioning Temporary Advance/Non-Refundable Advance from the General Provident Fund by the following categories of officers in the Forest and Wild Life Department are revised in supersession of all existing orders issued in the matter and regarding the
