O R D E R

Government are pleased to order that the entry fee for tourists in the Project Tiger Areas, All National Parks and Wild Life Sanctuaries of Kerala be revised as follows with immediate effect.

Project Tiger Areas & National Parks:

- a. Entry fee for Indian - Rs.10/- per head/day  
" Foreigner - Rs.50/- or 2 per head/day  
" for children below 12 years & bonafide students - Rs.2/- per head/day
- b. Fee for Video/Movie Camera - Rs.100/- per day
- c. Vehicle Entry fee :
  - i. Heavy vehicle - Rs.100/- per day
  - ii. Light Vehicle - Rs. 10/- per day
  - iii. Autorikshaw & 2 wheelers - Rs. 5/- per day
  - iv. Heavy vehicle carrying bonafide students - Rs. 25/- per day
- d. Film Shooting:
  - i. Commercial Films - Rs.2000/- per day
  - ii. Documentary/Education Film - Rs.1000/- per day
  - iii. Security deposit for all categories of film shooting - Rs.5000/-

The producers of films should supply 12 copies of still photograph of the size 12" x 10" to the Department free of cost. They should acknowledge the Wild Life Wing of Kerala Forest Department for the permission and services rendered and highlight a conservation message.

The vehicles owned by M/s. Tata Tea Limited passing through the Tourism Zone at Rajamali of the Eravikulam National Park will be exempted from entrance fee. They will obtain necessary permits from the Department for the purpose.

- " " for children below 12 years & bonafide students on tour - Re. 1/ per head/day
- b. Video & Movie Camera - Rs.100/- per day

  - i. Heavy vehicles - Rs.100/- per day
  - ii. Light vehicles - Rs. 10/- "
  - iii. Autorikshaw & 2 wheelers - Rs. 5/- "
  - iv. Heavy vehicles carrying bonafide students on tour - Rs. 25/- "
