ORDER

The Government have carefully examined the request made by the Perumpalam Island Government Servants Association for the grant of compensatory allowance in consideration of the difficulties experienced by them due to the peculiar geographic conditions of the Island and are pleased to order that the Government servants working in the offices/institutions in the Perumpalam Island will be granted compensatory allowance at half the rates laid down under class IV of Appendix IV, Kerala Service Rules (i.e. at half the rates of compensatory allowance given to Officers stationed in hill stations).

This allowance will be classified as Class VI Miscellaneous Compensatory Allowance under Appendix IV, Kerala Service Rules.
