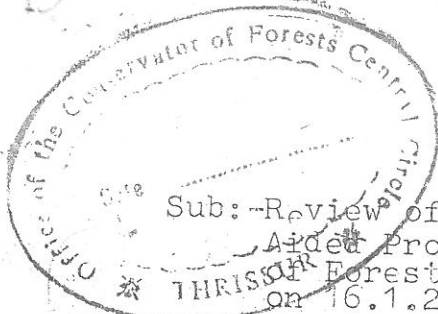

In the meeting of the Chief Conservators of Forests convened by the Honourable Chief Minister on 16.1.2003 to review the progress of Centrally Sponsored Schemes and Externally Aided Projects, the Hon'ble Chief Minister appealed that we should try for more central funds and fully utilize the sanctioned amounts. This will be monitored every 15 days. He assured that a minimum 80% of the State Plan amounts would be invariably provided during this year.
