ORDER

In clause (ii) of the G.O. read above it was ordered that the Travancore Plywood Industries should accept all species marked and entrusted to them including rejections. The General Manager, Travancore Plywood Industries, has now requested that the above clause in the G.O. may be suitably modified so as to include provision regarding working down of rejection.

The Chief Conservator of Forests has suggested that the firm should work down to the nearest depot all such logs within a fortnight from the date of felling, so that they can be measured over to other softwood consuming concerns, or auctioned openly. For such of the logs that fetch seignior age plus working charges, the working charges will be paid to the contractors engaged by the factory and for those logs sold for rates below seignior age rate plus working charges, the different from the sale proceeds and the seignior age will be paid to the contractors.

Government have examined the matter and are pleased to accept the above suggestion of the Chief Conservator of Forests. The G.O. read above stands modified to this extent.
