Sub:- Government demands for provision of telephone connections
Introduction of OYT scheme.

The Government of India have introduced OWN YOUR TELEPHONE SCHEME" in the telephone exchange systems at Trivandrum, Quilon, Alleppey, Kottayam, Ernakulam-Cochin, Trichur and Kozhikode with effect from 1-1-1968. Demands from the State Government for provision of new telephone connections are also to be met under this scheme, under which an amount of Rs. 2,500/- will be payable as initial lump sum deposit at the time of installation of the connection. A rebate in rental charges will be granted in respect of these connections at the rate of Rs. 120/- per annum in respect of rental charges paid on ~~quarterly~~ quarterly basis for a period of 20 years. You are requested to bring this revised procedure to the notice of all concerned to ensure that demands for telephone connections for the state Government at these places are sanctioned under the OYT scheme. A copy of the press Note released in this connection is also enclosed.

PRESS NOTE

Introduction of OYT scheme for registering of telephone demands in important exchange in Kerala.

Government of India have decided to introduce the OYT (own your Telephone) scheme in some of the large Telephone Exchanges in Kerala, such as Trivandrum, Quilon, Alleppey, Kottayam, Ernakulam-Cochin Trichur and Kozhikode with effect from 1st January 1968.

Fifty per cent of the available capacity in Telephone Exchange will be given exclusively to applicants under this scheme and they will be given telephone connections according to the date of their application, and these demands will be met on high priority. Under the scheme, an amount of Rs. 2,500 will be payable as initial lump sum deposit at the time of installation of the telephone connection. A rebats in rental charges will be granted to these charges paid--~~annually~~ and Rs. 30 subscribers at the rate of Rs. 120/- per annum in respect of rental charges paid annually; and Rs. 30/- per quarter in respect of rental charges paid on quarterly basis for a period of 20 years.

For meeting demands of the applicants, who are not in a position to pay the initial deposit under the OYT scheme 30% of the capacity will be reserved for such demands, which will be registered under 'General Category'. In addition, 20 per cent of the available capacity will be kept reserved for applicants coming in the "exempted category" of publicmen, Medical practitioners, Educational institutions, small scale Industries, public institutions etc.

All existing applicants in the waiting list for telephone connections in these exchange system are being addressed individually for ascertaining their option for coming under the OYT scheme. They will be asked to intimate their option within a period of about two months and those applicants who are prepared to take connections under this scheme, will be registered in the order of date of original applications under the OYT scheme. The new applicants for the OYT connections will be placed below all those who are at present in the waiting list and are willing to come under the OYT schemes.

The main advantage of OYT scheme is that these applicants for telephone connections will get priority over other applicants in the waiting list.
