ORDER

1. Several Orders have been issued by the Government empowering District Collectors to requisition Departmental Vehicles in the District for high priority items of work such as collection of arrears of Government dues, small savings promotion, during emergency etc. It has been brought to the notice of the Government that various restrictions imposed by some Heads of Departments on their department vehicles being requisitioned, have created difficulties for the District Collectors in assembling the required number of vehicles or ensuring their efficient utilization.

2. Government have examined the various orders in the matter in detail. In supersession of all orders in the matter and instructions issued by Heads of Departments, Government empower the District Collectors to requisition any department vehicle in their districts, except UNICEF Vehicles, for the following urgent matters.

- i. Maintenance of Law and Order.
- ii. Attending to work in connection with natural calamities.
- iii. Elections.

3. When a requisition for above purposes is made by the District Collector, the Officers concerned should

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should comply with it immediately without reference to their departmental Superior Officers.

4. In other circumstances the District Collectors may obtain the vehicles in consultation with the Heads of Offices concerned in their districts.

5. Notwithstanding these orders, Government can order requisitioning of vehicles by District Collectors for other important items of work like collection of arrears of revenue etc. whenever such a need arises.

6. All heads of Departments will note these orders for their future guidance and ensure compliance with them on the part of all their subordinate officers.
