ORDER

The Mundakayam Panchayat in its resolution read as 1st paper above has pointed out the urgent necessity to provide houses with the base minimum facilities for about 600 families who have been settled in the Panakkachira area after eviction from the road poramboke of Mundakayam town. The Panchayat has also expressed its willingness to undertake the construction of houses, if Government extend assistance by providing timber and tiles free of cost in accordance with the programme chalked out for the beneficiaries of One Lakh Houses Scheme for the construction of houses who were given houses sites only.

2. The District Collector in the letter read as 2nd paper above has reported that houses for 300 families have to be provided at present. The cost of tiles and timber required for construction of 300 single houses is estimated at Rs. 2,10,000 (Rs. 66,000 for tiles and Rs. 1,44,000 for timber respectively).

3. Government have examined the case and are pleased to accord sanction for the implementation of a scheme for the construction of 300 houses for the settlers of Panakkachira colony, in Mundakayam Panchayat. The tiles and timber required for the construction of 300 houses, approximate cost which is estimated to be Rs. 2.10 lakhs will be supplied to the Mundakayam panchayat free of cost. The procedure followed in regard to the supply of timber for One Lakh Houses Scheme will be allowed in this scheme also. The District Collector, Kottayam is authorised to purchase and distribute the required quantity of tiles as was done in the case of One Lakh Houses Scheme.
