Order

In the G.Os read above Government have ordered that the period of suspension of Government Servants detained under MISA except those who were released on tendering apology will be treated as duty for purposes of pay and allowances, pension and increment. A point has now come up for consideration as to whether the period of suspension which is treated as duty by virtue of the G.Os read above will be reckoned for calculating earned leave and other leave.

2. Government have examined the matter in detail in consultation with Government of India and wish to clarify that as in the case of Central Government Employees the period of suspension will not be counted for the purpose of calculating entitlement of earned leave and other leave.
