ORDER

In the G.O. read as first paper above, it has, inter alia, been ordered that temporary advances from the Provident Fund account of a subscriber will be granted to meet the cost of the subscriber's defence where he is prosecuted by the Government in any Court of Law in respect of any alleged misconduct on his part.

2. According to the Government of India Notification read as second paper above, temporary advances from the Provident Fund amount of a subscriber will be granted to meet the cost of his defence where he engages a legal practitioner to defend him in an enquiry.
3. Governments consider that the above facility should also be given to the officers of this State.
4. They are, therefore, pleased to order that temporary advances from Provident Fund credits of a subscriber will be granted to meet the cost of his defence where he engages a legal practitioner to defend himself in an enquiry.
5. Suitable amendments to the relevant Provident Fund Rules will be issued in due course.
