**ORDER**

The Government of India , in their Notification in read ,have changed the definition of the term “ Foreign service “ by amending rules 9(7) of the Fundamental Rules. According to the amendment, service in which a government Savant receives his pay from a source other than the Consolidated Fund of India or of a state is foreign service. Governments have decided to re-define the term “Foreign service” un rule 12(9) of the Kerala Service Rules, part I as that in the Fundamental Rules. Accordingly the following notification is hereby issued.

S.R.O.No.248/72-In Exercise of the powers conferred by section 2 of the Kerala public Service Act,1968(Act 19 of 1968) read with Section 3 there of the Government of Kerala hereby make the following amendment to the Kerala Service Rules, namely:-

**AMENDMENT**  
**C.S.No.238/72**

In the said rules, in rule 12,in part 1. for sub-rule(9) the following shall be substituted namely:-

“(9) Foreign Service –means servicer in which an officer receives his pay with the sanction of government from any source other than the Consolidated Fund of India or of a State”.
