NOTIFICATION

In exercise of the powers conferred by the proviso to Article 309 the Constitution of India, the Government of Kerala hereby makes the following amendments to the Kerala Service Rules namely:-

AMENDMENTS

C.S. No. 18/62 Dated, 21st July 1962

In Part I of the said rules.

- (i) in rule 60 (b) – Note 2 shall be deleted
Notes 3,4 and 5 shall be renumbered as 2,3 and 4 respectively; and
- (ii) the following shall be added as Note 5 after Note 4 renumbered:-

“Note 5- The permission given by this rule for an Officer being granted leave for not more than six months beyond the age at which he must compulsorily retire shall not be treated as carrying with it automatic extension of service and the officer shall cease to retain a lien on his permanent post or any other post during the period of such leave”
