**ORDER**

In the G.O. first cited, a clarification was issued to Rule 15 of the General Rules for the Kerala State and Subordinate services to the effect that if, for a vacancy allotted to particular major group of other backward classes a candidate belonging to the at major group is not available, the vacancy should go to the next major group among the other backward classes in the sub-rotation mentioned in Rule 17 (2) of the General Rules in which approved candidates are available, instead of the present system in which the vacancy will be allotted to the candidate from open competition.

2. Government has reconsidered the question in all its aspects, and are pleased to order that the G.O. (P) 1058/Public dated 16-12-1959 be cancelled and the status ante restored.
