ORDER

In consultation with the Kerala Public Service Commission the Government are pleased to direct that displaced persons from Pakistan be granted the following concessions.

1. Relaxation of upper age limit by three years for appointment to posts made on the basis of competitive examinations.
2. Relaxation of upper age limit up to 45 years for recruitment to posts other than those mentioned under (1)
3. Further relaxation of the above age limits by five years in the case of displaced persons belonging to Scheduled Castes and Scheduled Tribes.
4. Exemption from payment of application and / or examination fees for selection by the Kerala Public Service Commission if the applicant is not in a position to pay the prescribed fees. The Kerala Public Service Commission will exempt the candidate from payment of prescribed application or examination fee if it is satisfied that the applicant is a bonafide displaced person and is not in position to pay the prescribed fee.

- II. The concessions granted by this order will remain in force till the end of March 1963. It will be the duty of the candidates to produce adequate and authentic proof to establish that they are displaced persons etc to the satisfaction of the authorities.
