## **ORDER**

In the G.O read above as second paper it was ordered that the appointment of typist6s as stenographers after test by the Public Service Commission in the respective Departments made as per the orders in the G.O. first cited should be treated as promotion and that all the concessions available to promotes will be given to the typists so promoted as Stenographers.

2. Now a question has been raised whether the appointment of U.D. Typists on Rs. 90-200 as Stenographers on Rs. 50-200 as per the G.O. first cited ca be treated as promotion. The appointment in this case is from a post having higher scale of pay to a post having a lower time scale of pay. Government therefore direct that the appointment of U.D. typists on Rs. 92-200 as Stenographers on Rs. 50-200 as per the G.O.first cited shall not be treated as promotion. Consequently, the concessions available to promotes will not be extended to such U.D. Typists appointed as Stenographers. This order applies to all similar cases when appointment is from a post carrying a higher scale of pay to another in a lower scale.
