ORDER

In the G.O. read as first paper above, Government issued orders in consultation with the Public Service Commission prescribing a uniform procedure for recruitment to the posts of Drivers of motor vehicles in departments other than the Police Department, by transfer from other classes/categories in other services. As per special rules issued in G.O. (P) No.120/73/PD dated 30-4-1973, the method of appointment of drivers is: (i) by promotion from any other class or category in the General Subordinate Services or by transfer from any other service, or (ii) in the absence of suitable candidates under item (i) above, by direct recruitment. According to this scheme, the Director of Employment has to prepare district-wise lists of persons who have been declared as qualified for appointment as drivers by the Regional Transport Officers. Vacancies arising in any department should be notified to the Director of Employment and he has to advise names from the lists so prepared. In the letter read as 2nd paper above, the Directors of Employment proposed that it would be more convenient for him if the employers notify vacancies to the District/Divisional Employment Officers of the district concerned and the letter permitted to sponsor candidates according to their rank in the district list and that the final district-wise ranked lists will be forwarded by him to the respective district/divisional offices. Government examined the proposal in consultation with the Public Service Commission and ordered in G.O. 3rd paper cited that the appointing authorities will notify the vacancies of drivers to the District/Divisional Employment Officers concerned and the letter will advise candidates according to he rank in the final list of the district concerned. For the above purpose the Director of Employment will forward the final district-wise ranked lists prepared by him following the procedure prescribed in the scheme annexed to the GO. Read as first paper above to the District/Divisional Employment Officers.

2. It had come to the notice of the Government that certain appointing authorities are not strictly following the procedure prescribed for the appointment of drivers. Therefore, Government in Circular No.8853/Adv.C3/89/P&ARD. Dated 23-6-1989 instructed all appointing authorities to follow the procedure in G.O.(P) No.202/72/PD dated 22-5-1972.

3. The Director of Employment in his letter read as 5th paper above, has suggested that the procedure for reporting of vacancies of drivers to District Employment Office/Divisional Employment Office prescribed in G.O.(P)48/73/PD dated 6-2-1973 may be continued. Government are therefore pleased to order that the procedure fixed in G.O.(P)48/73/PD dated 6-2-1973 for notifying the vacancies of drivers by appointing authorities to the District Employment advise candidates, will continue. The last Para in Circular dated 23-6-1989 is modified to the above extent.
