**GENERAL PROVIDENT FUND (KERALA) RULES—WITHDRAWAL FROM THE FUND—
REVISION OF UPPER MONETARY LIMIT FOR VARIOUS CATEGORIES OF
SANCTIONING OFFICERS—ORDERS ISSUED**

ORDER

The Upper Monetary Limit for sanctioning Temporary Advance/ Non-refundable Advance by different categories of Officers in various departments has been modified and orders issued in the Government Order, read as 2nd paper.

Now, it has been brought to the notice of Government that the upper monetary limit specified therein is causing undue delay and inconvenience in sanctioning advances consequent on revision of pay and allowances of State Government Employees.

There have also been instances of certain Administrative Departments issuing orders fixing different rates of monetary limits to different categories of Officers to sanction Temporary Advance/Non-refundable Advances from General Provident Fund.

Government have examined the matter in detail and are pleased to revise the existing upper monetary limit to various categories of Sanctioning Authorities, in partial modification of the G.Os. The Upper Monetary Limit fixed for different categories of Sanctioning Authorities shall be subject to General Provident Fund Rules and Standing Orders and Delegation of Powers granted to the Officers.

The categorization of Officers and Monetary Limits fixed herein shall be in supersession of all existing orders issued in the matter.

Each Head of Department shall issue an order specifying the Designation of Officers under his control to be included under the above categories and intimate the same to Government and Accountant General, Kerala, Thiruvananthapuram.

Necessary amendments to the Book of Financial Powers will be issued separately.
