RETIRED FROM SERVICE-AMENDMENT ISSUED.**

NOTIFICATION

In exercise of the powers conferred by the proviso to Art 309 of the Constitution of India, the Governor of Kerala hereby makes the following amendment to the Kerala Service Rules, namely:-

AMENDMENT

C.S. No 46/61 dated 14th December 1961.

In Part III of the said rules, after 5, the following rule shall be added, namely:-

5A (a)-An officer compulsorily retired from service by way of penalty may be granted by the authority competent to impose such penalty, pension and death-cum-retirement gratuity that would have been admissible to the officer if he had been invalidated on medical certificate on the date of such retirement, provided, however, that the authority imposing the penalty of compulsory retirement may order a reduction either in pension or in death-cum-retirement gratuity or in both of the circumstances of any particular case warrant such a reduction.

(b)- Where a person who has been granted pension dies within five years of his compulsory retirement and his family is entitled to a family pension under rule 88 in this part, the family pension admissible will be half the amount of the pension actually sanctioned subject to the usual maximum Rs. 150 and minimum of Rs.30 subject to the further condition that the minimum pension if not in any case exceed the full amount of the pension sanctioned to the deceased officer per mensem. The amount, if any ordered to be reduced in the death-cum-retirement gratuity as a penalty should be reduced in the death-cum-retirement gratuity, as a penalty should be reduced when residuary gratuity given under Rule 77 Part III of the rules.”

This notification shall be deemed to have come into force with effect on and from 1st November 1956.
