NOTIFICATION

In exercise of the powers conferred by the Proviso to Article 309 of the Constitution of India, the Government of Kerala hereby makes the following amendment to the Kerala Service Rules, namely:-

AMENDMENT

C.S. NO. 41/62

In Part II of the said Rules, in rule 20, the following shall be inserted as a proviso, namely:-

“Provided that where  $\frac{1}{2}$  D.A is claimed under Rule 63, of this part at the commencement or end of a day’s journey, incidental expenses at the prescribed rates will be paid for the journey subject to a minimum of  $\frac{1}{2}$  D.A”
