ORDER

According to the Liberalized Family Pension Scheme introduced by the G.O.read as first paper 'family' for the purpose of the scheme will include wife/husband and minor children including children legally adopted before retirement. In the G.O.read as second paper, it was further clarified that a judicially separated wife/husband of a Government employee will be eligible for the benefits of the. Liberalized family pension Scheme. The Government of India in their office Memorandum read as third paper above amended the provision in their family pension scheme to the effect that the authority competent to sanction the family pension may in a suitable case, for reasons to be recorded in writing, pay the minor children in preference to the widower who is judicially separated.

On the analogy of the amendment issued by the Government of India, Government are pleased to order that the authority competent to sanction the family pension may in a suitable case, for reasons to be recorded in writing pay family pension to the minor children in preference to the widower who is judicially separated.
