NOTIFICATION

S.R.O. No. 1062/75 – In exercise of the powers conferred by subsection (1) of section 2 of the Kerala Public Services Act, 1986, (19 of 1968) the Government of Kerala hereby make the following amendments to the kerala Government Servant's Conduct Rules, 1960, namely

AMENDMENT

In the said Rules,-

- (1) in sub clause (i) of clause (i) to sub rule (a) of rule 77, the word "ordinarily" shall be deleted.
- (2) The existing note after sub-clause (1) to sub rule of rule 77 shall be numbered as Note 2 and before that note as sp numbered the following shall be inserted as Note 1, namely:-
"Note 1 Class I and Class II officers shall not be allowed to be minters in the same association in which Class III officers are members and voice versa"

Explanatory Note

(This note is not part of the notification, but is intended to indicated its general purport)

According to Rule 77 (a) 1 (a) of the Kerala Government Servant's conduct rules, 1960, one of the conditions for the grant of recognition to a service association is that the association must ordinary consist of a distinct class of government employees and must represent 25% of the total strength of that class of 50 person which ever is higher. The term "Class" occurring in the above rule has not been defined and as such Government are not legally in a position to deny recognition to service associations consisting of different categories of employees ie, service associations consisting of class I class II and class III employees. Government consider that it is not proper for senior officers to be associated with officers of the lower relevant rule in this regard so that class I and Class II officers may not the members in the same associations in which class III officers are members and vice versa. This notification is indented to achieve the above object.
