NOTIFICATION

S.R.O.No. 512./77. In exercise of the powers conferred by subsection (1) of section 2 of the Kerala Public Services Act, 1968 (19 of 1968), read with section 3 thereof, the Government of Kerala hereby make the following amendment to the Kerala State and Subordinate Services Rules, 1958, namely:-

AMENDMENT

In part I of the said rules, to clause (14) of rule 2, the following explanation shall be added, namely:-

“Explanation:- A member of a Scheduled Tribe, shall not cease to be a member of that Scheduled Tribe on change of religion.”

Explanatory Note

(This note is not part of the notification, but is intended to indicate its general purport.)

In G.O. Ms. No. 647/PD dated 9-8-1961 Government ordered that a member of a Scheduled Tribe even after conversion to some other religion, will continue to enjoy the benefits admissible to Scheduled Tribes in the matter of reservation of appointments in Public Services. It is proposed to give statutory validity of the above order. This notification is intended to achieve the above object.
