## ORDER

In G.O read above, orders were issued authorizing the Conservator's of Forests, Kozhikode and the Divisional Forest Officers of Kozhikode Circle, to incur expenditure up to a limit of Rs. 300/- and Rs. 100/- respectively in each case for transport of seizurres involved in offences under the M.P.P.P Act. The Board of Revenue has been pointed out that the Tahsildars will have to take action in respect of seizures involved in offences under Madras Forest Act and Kerala Land Conservancy Act. The Board has, therefore, recommended that the Tahsildars of the Malabar area may be authorized to in our expenditure up to a limit of Rs. 100/- in individuals cases for transport of seizures involved in offences under Madras Forest Act and in Land Conservancy cases and that Tahsildars of Travancore Cochin are may be authorized to incur expenditure up to the above limit in respect of offences under Kerala Land Conservatory Act.

- 2. The Chief Conservator of Forests has agreed to the recommendations of the Board of Revenue.
- 3. Having considered the question, in detail the Government are pleased to accept the above recommendation of the Board of Revenue and they order accordingly.
