O R D E R

According to item 3 of the Delegation of Administrative powers given under the G.O read above. Heads of Department are authorized sanction all kinds of leave except study leave and special disability leave to officers under them in case where no substitutes are required and also to make arrangements for additional charge and sanction charge allowance under Rule 33 (b) and (ii) and (iii) of K.S.R

A doubt has been raised about the power of the Heads of Departments in regard to the making of charge arrangements sanctioning of charge advances when a post falls vacant due to reasons other than leave e.g. by transfer, promotion etc., Government they due consideration of the question are pleased to clarify that the Heads of Departments competent to make arrangements for additional charge even in vacancies which may arise due to reasons other than grant of leave.

G.O.P No. 248/Public dated 24.4.1962 will stand modified this extent.
