Public Services-Kerala Government Servant's Application for Posts (Private Employment and Government service) Rules, 1958 /amendment issued.

NOTIFICATION

S.R.O.No..... In exercise of the powers conferred section (1) of section 2 of the Kerala Public Service Act, 68 (19 of 1963) the Government of Kerala hereby make the following amendments to the Kerala Government Servants Application for Posts (Private Employment and Government services) Rules, 1958 namely.

AMENDMENTS

In the said Rules, in rule 3,

1. the existing rule (4) shall be renumbered as clause (a) of that sub rule; and

2. after clause (a) as so renumbered, the following clause shall be added, namely:-

- (i) Permission to accept private employment in Kerala state or other states in India by an Officer on leave shall be granted only after careful examination of each case with special reference to the post held by the officer and also the post he is to take up during the period of leave.
- (ii) If the employment is outside India and has nothing to do with the applicant's position as a Government Servant, permission may be granted.
- (iii) In either case the grant of leave shall be subject to the relieving conditions, namely:-

1. Leave without Allowance if any granted will not be counted for pension and will be recorded so in the service book.
2. In the case of an Officer who is eligible for Appointment to a selection post but who has not been included in the "select List" at the time of granting leave appointment to the selection post will be made only after his performance is assessed and his case considered by the Departmental promotion committee, on his return from leave.
3. In the case of an officer who has been included in the 'select list' at the time of granting the leave appointment to the selection post may be ordered on his return from leave, subject to availability of vacancy. In the case of non selection posts, appointment will be made during the period of leave and the officer allowed to continue in leave, subject to other conditions being satisfied.

Explanatory Note

(This note is not part of the Notification but is interested to indicate its general purpose)

Rule 69, Part I , Kerala Service Rules, lays down that an officer on leave may not take up any service or accept any employment without obtains the previous sanction of the authority empowered it fill up the post help by him. The above rule does not apply to casual literacy work or to service as an examiner or similar employment or acceptance of foreign service governed by the rules under chapter XI part I Kerala Service Rules K.S.R.S. Requests have been received from Government Servants for grant of leave including leave without allowances and for permission for take-up other employment especially tin foreign countries during the period of leave. Government have examined the Question in details and have issued orders in G.O (P) 247/70/Fin.dated 29/4/70 laying down the guide lines for the grant of leave in such cases. It is decided to amend the Kerala Government Servant's Application for posts Rules,1958 so that the orders in the above G.O will have statutory validity.

This Notification is intended to achieve the above object.
