ORDER

As per the Government Order first cited, provisional/emergency appointment made under rule 9(a) (i) or 31 of the Kerala State and Subordinate Service Rules on regularization will be treated as officiating appointment ab-initio for the purpose of granting increments. It was further, clarified in the circular Memorandum read as there paper above that the intention of Government is to allow the benefit of G.O.(P) 301/67/Fin. Dt. 24-7-1967 in all cases where the subsequent regular appointment is to a post not different from the category provisionally held by the Government Servant. In order to incorporate the above orders in the Kerala Service Rule Govt. are pleased to introduce the following as Government Decision No.2 numbering the existing decisions as Government Decision No. 1 under rule 33 part I Kerala Service rules.

Government Decisions No. 57/76

GOVERNMENT DECISION NO. 2

Provisional service on regularization with or without break in the same category of post will be treated as officiating service ab-inito for the limited purpose of granting of increments.

The term 'same category of post' for the purpose denotes posts satisfying the following conditions:-

- (i) The posts should carry the same or identical scale of pay
- (ii) The qualification and method of appointment should be the same; and
- (iii) The posts should fall in the same service

The above decision shall be deemed to have come into force with effect from 1-11-1956 but the monetary benefit thereto will be admissible only with effect from 24-7-1967.
