S.R.O.No. 401/81.- In exercise of the powers conferred by subsection (1) of section 2 of the Kerala Public Services Act, 1968 (19 of 1968,) read with section 3 thereof, the Government of Kerala hereby make the following further amendment to the Special Rules for the Kerala Last Grade Service published under Notification G.O.(P) No. 82/Public (Rules) Department dated the 8th March, 1966, in Part I of the Kerala Gazette No. 14 dated the 5th April, 1966, namely:-

AMENDMENT

In the said rules, in the Table under sub-rule (b) of rule 8, for clause (2) of the Notes, the following shall be substituted, namely:-

“(2) For appointment by direct recruitment to the posts of Chowkidars and Messengers in the Administrative Secretariat and for appointment by recruitment of males, to the posts of peons, ability to ride a bicycle will be an essential qualification.”

Explanatory Note

(This note is not part of the amendment, but is intended to indicate its general purport)

According to the existing provisions in the Special Rules for the Kerala Last Grade Service, ability to ride a bicycle is an essential qualification for appointment to the post of Peon by direct recruitment. Governments have since decided to exempt women candidates from this essential qualification for being appointed as Peon. This notification is intended to achieve the above object.
